



Commercial Fire Cause & Origin Assistance

In Mid-June, a suburban auto body shop experienced a large fire in the middle of the night. The fire department arrived quickly and worked all night and most of the following day. The large fire, due to their efforts, affected none of the nearby businesses, although fire destroyed the majority of the body shop and its contents.

Robinette Demolition was called to the fire-damaged site to help secure the area around the fire, and to assist in the cause and origin investigation. A fence was placed around the perimeter of the site for safety purposes and with a four man team, one bobcat, one forklift, and one crane, Robinette Demolition worked overtime to remove more than 30 vehicles from the building for evidence, and move or remove debris so that investigators had safe access to areas under examination.

After assisting with the cause and origin investigation, Robinette removed the remainder of the building and all fire-damaged debris. In addition, at the local government's request, we shored a wall and left it in place to prevent a public safety hazard.
